• How long does it last?

Plan on at least 20-minutes to walk through and enjoy the lights, although you may spend more or less time depending on your preferences. Guests are welcome to stay and enjoy festive snacks and beverages until the event closes 8:45pm.

• Can I take photos?

Yes, taking photos and videos is encouraged, if you post on social media, please tag us!

• How should I dress?

Comfortable attire and dress for the seasonal weather temperature. Check the weather forecast in advance of your experience date and time. Comfortable walking shoes are encouraged. Please note that the Woodland Forest is a natural setting with changing elevations, so please watch your step. Some benches and seating are provided along the trails.

• Where should I park?

• Who can visit the experience?

The experience is designed for all ages.

• Where are the restrooms?
