Field Trips free with advance reservation

- **Self-guided Tours** (All Grades) Maximum group size is 30
- **Dixon Discoveries** (Grades PreK 12) Includes an interactive tour of the museum or gardens and a hands-on activity that aligns with curriculum standards | Maximum group size is 75
- **Tour & Sketch** (Grades 6 12) Includes sketching supplies for students to draw in the museum and/or gardens and guided tour to learn about current exhibitions | Maximum group size is 50

REQUIREMENTS

Chaperone/student ratio of 1:5 required for PreK - 5th grade groups and 1:7 for 6th - 12th grade groups.
