

2023 Daffodil Bulb Sale Information

Thank you for your continued interest in and enthusiasm for daffodils!

The daffodil bulb sale price list is on Dixon's website: www.dixon.org via the Calendar (October 29 event).

On Saturday, October 29, 2022, the Daffodil Bulb Sale will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the Catmur Horticulture Building (the potting hub) at Dixon Gallery and Gardens, 4339 Park Avenue, Memphis.

We have ordered 56 different varieties, the majority of which we have not sold within the last couple of years—with many new cultivars we have never sold.

This will be an in-person sale only, and we are not able to accept any pre-orders. If you will be out of town on October 29, please give your wish list to a friend and let them shop for you. As before with in-person sales, we will have a color photo of each cultivar for sale, along with a short description and information about size, typical bloom time, etc. We have plenty of bulbs for everyone! We did the pre-orders during COVID, but we are back to an in-person only sale.

Explanation of Color Codes Adjoining Names of Daffodils on Pricelist:

The price list is divided by the Divisions, or types, of daffodils; and a color code describes each variety. A color code is assigned to the flower by the hybridizer or registrant at the Royal Horticultural Society at the time of introduction. An example is Division 2: 'Merels Favourite' W-Y. The letters stand for colors: Y=Yellow, P=Pink, R=Red, G=Green, W=White, and O=Orange. The petals are collectively call the perianth, and the trumpet or cup is called the corona. The first letter or letters of the color code describes the perianth color(s) from tip, mid-zone, to base, followed by a hyphen; and a second letter(s) describes the corona colors(s) from the eye of the flower, to the mid-zone, to the rim. 'Merels Favourite' has white petals and a yellow trumpet.

Excellent photographs of all varieties being offered are at the American Daffodil Society's free web site: www.daffseek.org. Accessing the photographs is very simple by merely entering each cultivar name onto the website's screen. In addition to photos, other useful information is available. You will be surprised at how quickly you can see the pictures of all 56 varieties. As indicated at the bottom of the pricelist, most of the daffodils available are also illustrated in the Brent and Becky's Bulbs' catalogue and at their website: Brentandbeckysbulbs.com. Interesting commentary about each bulb adjoins their photographs.

We look forward to seeing you on Saturday, October 29, at the daffodil bulb sale!
